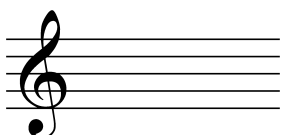

The length between the lowest-pitched note and the highest-pitched one is the **song field**.

Remember: time and anacrusis

The **time signature** indicates the amount of beats in each time:

- The **2 time** has two beats: the first one is strong, and the second one, weak.
- The **3 time** has three beats: the first one is strong, and the other two, weak.
- The **4 time** has four beats: the first one is strong, and the other three, weak.

There are songs that start with a weak beat before the first strong beat. These start with **anacrusis**.

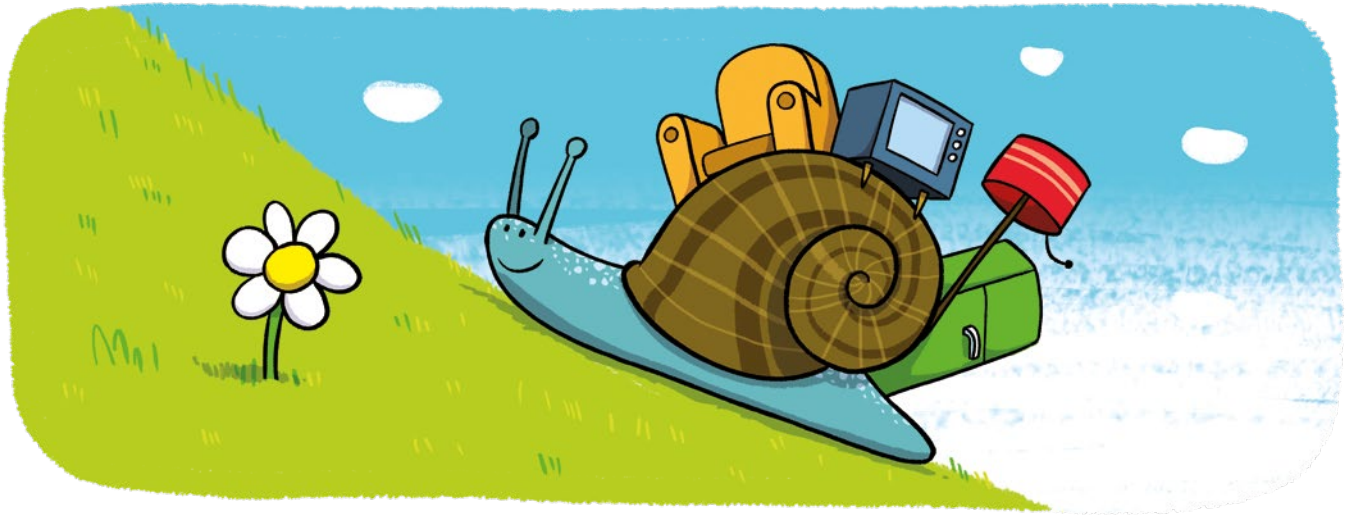
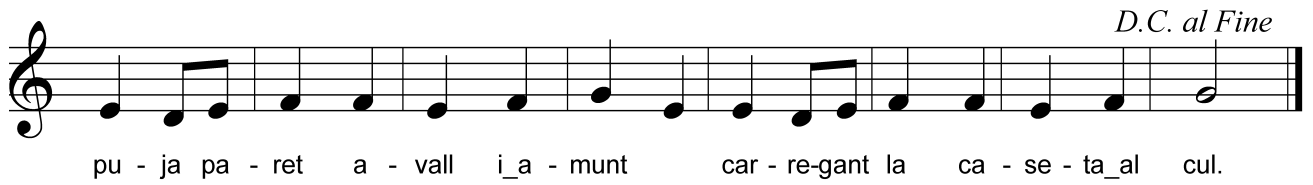
